





OPERA FUDGE

This indulgent confection is a genuine Lebanon Valley original that features a creamy center dipped in pure chocolate liquor and can be found throughout the area. The Wertz and Van Winkle families have been making Opera Fudge and other handmade treats for almost a century.

SHUEY'S PRETZELS

Shuey's award-winning pretzels have been carefully handcrafted and coal-roasted since 1927. Shuey's hard pretzels can be found at many area locations. But Saturday soft pretzel sales at their bakery in Lebanon draw young and old alike, forming lines out the door, and are only available while supplies last.



LEBANON BOLOGNA

A trip to the Lebanon Valley is only complete with a taste of the one and only Lebanon Bologna, which has been prepared in our area since the late 1700s. This 100% beef smoked sausage is the perfect addition to any charcuterie board. Seltzer's Smokehouse Meats has been making Lebanon Bologna with special seasonings and hardwood smoked since 1902.

SHOOFLY PIE

Nothing says Pennsylvania Dutch quite like a base of molasses and brown sugar with a buttery crumb topping - affectionately known as Shoofly Pie. This must-try dessert can be found on the menu of many local restaurants and roadside stands. We recommend trying a few to taste the different family recipes.





WHOOPIE PIES

Originally made with two chocolate cake rounds and a sweet vanilla filling, these handheld treats now feature various flavors. The best Whoopie Pies are homemade and available at select bakeries, farmers markets, and grocery stores throughout the Valley.







PENNSYLVANIA CHAUTAUQUA

In 1892 a group of Evangelical United Brethren members identified Mount Gretna as a good location for a Chautauqua. Like hundreds of Chautauquas, Mount Gretna's "Pennsylvania Chautauqua" was modeled after the original institute established on Lake Chautauqua, New York, in 1874.

Within a few years, they constructed a vaulted conical-roofed outdoor auditorium for services and concerts. The first Chautauquans built summer cottages around it, a Hall of Philosophy for meetings, and a small wooden Greek temple. Both buildings are still in use today.






